Surcharge is a new option under Automatic Adjustments that allows merchants to apply a percentage-based fee specifically to credit card transactions.

What is Surcharging?

Surcharge is a new option in Automatic Adjustments for SwipeSimple that implements a compliant way to apply a surcharge on credit card transactions. Available exclusively on PAX Terminals, this feature applies a reseller-defined percentage to all credit card transactions.

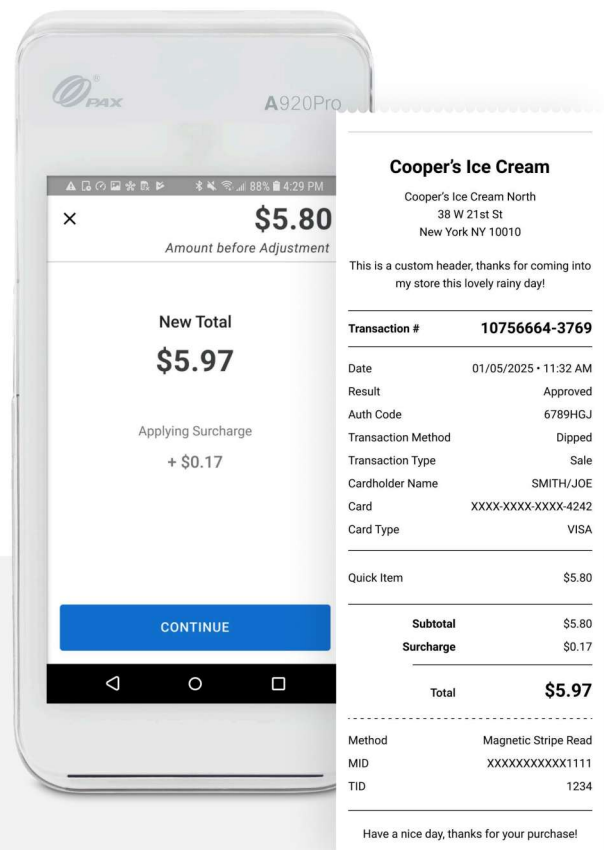

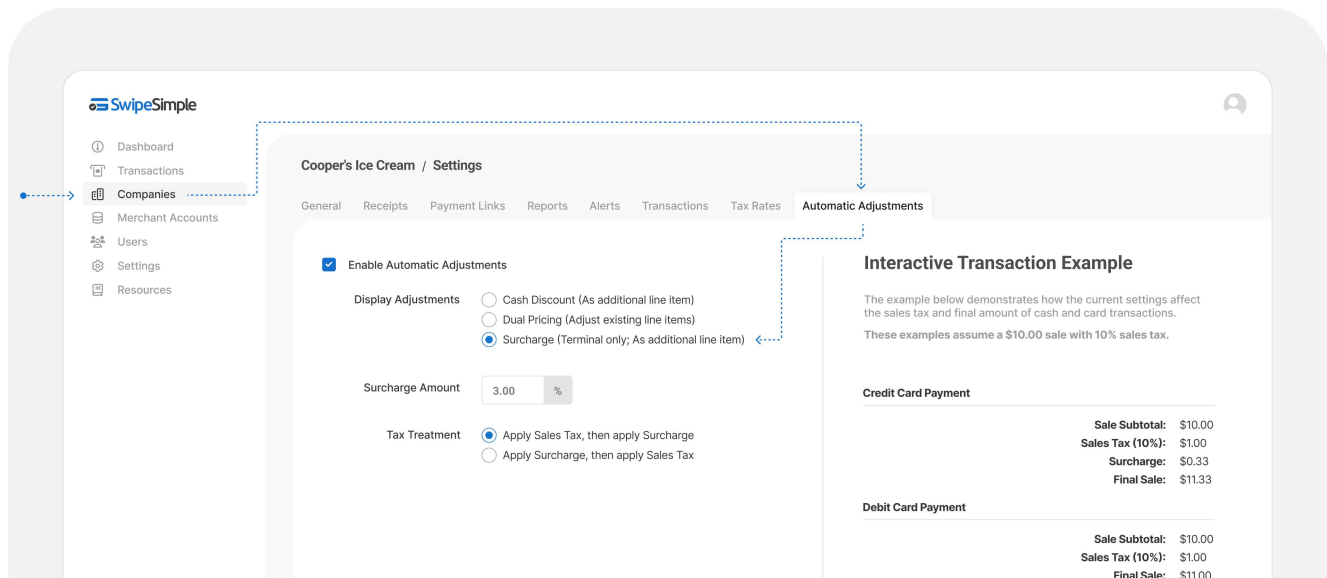
Automatically detects credit vs. debit cards, applying surcharge only when permitted.



Setting Up Surcharge

An eligible Reseller can enable Surcharge through Company settings > Automatic Adjustments.

Select "Surcharge (Terminal only; As additional line item)", adjust the percentage amount, and choose how tax is treated (before or after Surcharge).

Customer Transaction Flow

When a customer pays with a credit card, they'll see the original amount, the surcharge clearly labeled, and the new total. For debit cards, no surcharge appears. All surcharges display as separate line items on receipts, maintaining full transparency.
